External Assessor Reliability Training (EART) for the Youth Program Quality Assessment

Virtual Course October 20, 25, 26 and 28, 2021 (details below)

This workshop is intended for participants who will serve as reliable external assessors in the Youth Program Quality Intervention (YPQI) process who do not have a current endorsement (i.e. new assessors). Reliable assessors must meet rigorous standards that require in-depth exploration of the Program Quality Assessment (PQA). Participants must attend the entire training (4 days) over the course of which, they will watch a series of videos and practice scoring the PQA under the guidance of an experienced reliable rater from the Weikart Center. The training culminates in a video reliability check where participants must achieve 80% reliability to pass.
